- You will have responsibility for commercial security ensuring SALs/DEFCONS are in place and relevant.

- Responsibility for maintaining company security policy ensuring it remains relevant and proportionate.
- Responsibility for the team is educated in security awareness and that security awareness campaigns are run to ensure security education remains relevant.
- Maintaining relationships with commercial and government security advisors
- You will be responsible for the Key Production Function and processes
- You will work with the Head of Operations and the IT team to ensure that IT systems are secure and meeting contractual and commercial certification requirements, e.g. ISO27001, Cyber Essentials.
